DRUG TESTING

All archers attending this tournament will be liable to drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If any competitor refuses, that refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Entry forms submitted on behalf of archers under the age of 18 must be signed by a parent or guardian confirming that such archer will be permitted to submit to a drug test if requested to do so.

INSURANCE

All archers should be able to produce their Archery GB membership cards on the day of the competition if requested by a Judge or Tournament Organiser. Archers unable to produce their membership cards may not be permitted to shoot.
